





DACHSHUND - AKA THE WIENER DOG

Dachshunds are also known as wiener dogs due to their long body.

The Dachshund is an active, muscular, fearless, intelligent dog with a long body and short legs. It is very energetic and needs a lot of exercise. The Dachshund is a low-slung dog. The fur is black, chocolate, tan, red, or gray. Some Dachshunds are short-haired, some are wire-haired, and others are long-haired with sleek, slightly wavy hair and a fringed tail. Standard Dachshunds are from 5 to 10 inches tall at the shoulders and weigh from 16 to 32 pounds. Miniature Dachshunds weigh 11 pounds or less as an adult.
